Within the framework of the "East-West Dialogue" program of the German Academic Exchange Service Ass. Prof. Dr. Nataliia Mushak was invited by the Institute of East European Law of Kiel Universits and granted a monthly scholarship for a research stay including university lectures. The research stay covered the period between 01 July 2018 and 01 August 2018.
